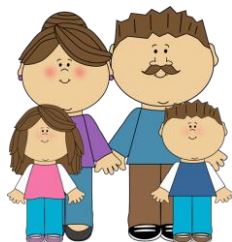




NOVEMBER (3) NEWSLETTER

Medication

School can only administer prescribed medication. Medicines including syrups, creams etc. bought over the counter from pharmacists cannot be administered in school. Written authority must be received from parents/guardians before prescribed medicines are administered in school. A form to be completed by parents/carers for this purpose is available from the school office. **Verbal messages received via pupils will not be accepted.**

Prescribed medication should be brought to the school by the parents/carers and handed personally to a member of staff in the school office. Children are **not allowed** to bring any non-prescribed medicines, throat lozenges, creams, lip balms etc. into school. If your child's medical details change throughout the year or they receive a new diagnosis, please let Mrs Cowan know as soon as possible.



Sickness/Diarrhoea

A reminder that children and staff should be kept away from school for **48 hours** from the last episode of **diarrhoea or vomiting**. Please support us in adhering to this advice from Public Health England.
