URGENT SAFETY MESSAGE FOR ALL

We understand that there is limited parking on Thorneyholme Terrace and as it is a one way street with cars parked either side it is not the safest place for lots of cars to be turning around when there are lots of children around. For the safety of all the children and their families and out of consideration for the residents and church users we therefore ask you to use the car parks nearby. There is **free parking** in the car park adjacent to the police station and also in the Scott Street car park behind the Front Street, as well as in the old bus station car park. All of these car parks are only a couple of minutes walk from school. Please ask any family member or friend who brings your child to school or collects them at home time to use the nearby car parks.

Also, please **do not use the church grounds** for parking. Access to school through the church gates is strictly on foot only. The car parking spaces within the church grounds are for people visiting Fr Kevin or for parishioners attending church. Access into the church grounds needs to be kept clear at all times e.g. for funerals, disabled access. When walking up and down the cemetery path, please ensure your child stays on the path and, out of respect, does not run among the graves. We appreciate your continued support in all aspects of school life.



Children in Y2 will be going swimming each Monday next half term. They will need to bring their swimming kit (including swimming hat), a towel and a warm coat and sensible shoes as they will be walking to the Louisa Centre each Monday morning.

As the weather improves (hopefully), please remember to protect your child from the sun. Please make sure they have a **sun hat or cap**, a **drink of water** (unflavoured, still) and apply some **sun protection** before they leave the house if the forecast indicates high temperatures. There are high factor sun lotions available that can be applied before the children come to school that would last them the entire day which would save the children having to reapply lotion. If necessary, children can bring sun protection cream to school to be applied at lunchtime, however as children are responsible for applying their own cream they may not get the necessary protection or get it in their eyes, therefore we strongly advise the use of long lasting protection. Any cream/lotion brought into school should be clearly marked with your child's name and left in the office. Please also ensure your child's uniform has their name marked on the labels as when the weather is hot the children take their jumpers off more often. Please regularly check your child's uniform to ensure they haven't taken the wrong sweatshirt home.
