Y6 LAST DAY

- As is tradition on the last day of term, children in Y6 will be leaving school a little early. They will be leaving via the KS2 playground (next to the cemetery) so that the whole school can be there to say goodbye. Y6 will be leaving at 2.10pm and if they have a younger brother or sister in school, they will be able to go home at the same time. Parents/carers can congregate in the area just outside the office - with your cameras at the ready! All children including Y6 should wear their uniform as normal on the last day of term.

Y6 would like to invite their families to a very special event on Monday 13th July at 6.30pm in the school hall. The children in Y6 are proving to be a very talented group of actors. As is tradition, to celebrate the end of their time with us, they are performing one of Shakespeare's well known plays. This year's play is 'Twelfth Night'. Please remember to bring a hankie - not only because Y6 are leaving (we will miss them) but also to dry the tears of laughter as you won't be able to stop. Prepare to be amazed and entertained. It will be a night to remember! No tickets are needed for the performance but we will be holding a collection on the night and the proceeds will go towards covering the cost of props and costumes.



As the weather improves, please remember to protect your child from the sun. Please make sure they have a **sun hat or cap**, a **drink of water** (unflavoured, still) and apply some **sun protection** before they leave the house if the forecast indicates high temperatures. Children can also bring sun protection cream to school to be applied during the day. The cream should be clearly marked with your child's name. Children will be responsible for applying their own cream. Please also ensure your child's uniform has their name marked on the labels as when the weather is hot the children take their jumpers off more often.



Weather permitting, Y6 will be going on a bike ride on Friday 10th July. They will be leaving school at round 10am and cycling to Our Lady & St Joseph's School, Brooms in Leadgate. The school have kindly agreed that we can use their school playing field to play football and rounders etc. Children will also eat their packed lunch outside. If your child doesn't have a bike or doesn't want to take part then they should come to school as normal and will remain in school for the day. Children will be back to school for normal home time.

Children will need a packed lunch for the bike ride. School can provide a packed lunch for every child on the day and the cost is £1.95 (children entitled to free school meals are entitled to a free packed lunch). Packed lunches will include a sandwich, vegetable sticks, biscuit, fresh fruit and a drink.
