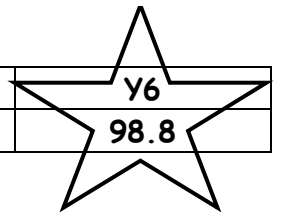
I hope you and your families had a happy Christmas and a good holiday. Best Wishes to you all for 2015.
