School Fund

Thank you very much for your continuing contributions to School Fund. As you know, School Fund is used to subsidise trips, activities and events for children throughout the school year.

As you will have noticed from the last newsletter, school fund donations together with trip donations do not cover the cost of the additional trips, activities and events organised for the children. Whilst we do not want to reduce the additional experiences we provide for the children we do have to bear in mind that we only have limited funds.

We understand that the cost of some trips has increased over recent years due mainly to increased transport costs and have therefore given parents/carers the option to donate over a number of weeks rather than send in their contributions in one lump sum. This has proved popular with families. We are therefore seeking your views on how you would prefer to make donations for school fund and additional activities, events and trips. One option would be to make a weekly payment e.g. £1 each week which would cover the cost of all trips, events, activities including Christmas parties and theatrical shows throughout the whole year. (This does not include the Y6 residential visit to Kingsway.)

I would be grateful if you would complete the slip overleaf to indicate how you would prefer to make donations. Please return the slip to the school office by Friday 5th February 2016. If you prefer to fill it in anonymously then please leave the space for your child's name blank.

Obviously our fundraising activities for charities would still go ahead as normal.

Once again, thank you very much for all the support you give to school, it is very much appreciated.
