<p>Maths Tasks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Access White Rose Maths home learning materials. - Play on Numbots. To practise recall of addition and subtraction facts. - Choose a number between 1 and 20. Can you represent this number in as many ways as possible? E.g. using dienes blocks, straws, beads, counters, words, tens frame, part/whole. - Can you practise sorting objects into 2s, 5s and 10s. Can you sort them in other ways? By colour, size, material etc? - Play on Hit the Button. Practise your number bonds to 10 and addition within 10. 	<p>Reading Tasks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read a book every day. This could be on Oxford Reading Buddy or one from home. - Listen to a story read by someone else. How did you feel about the book? What is your favourite part?
<p>Phonics/Spelling Tasks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Practise phase 2 and phase 3 sounds. - Practise phase 2 and phase 3 tricky words. <p>(Find resources such as a sound mat on the Year 1 class page to support you with this)</p> <p>Useful Spelling Websites</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Phonics play - Top Marks - Spelling - Spelling City 	<p>Writing Tasks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Draw a picture of yourself and label it. Label your body parts e.g. head, neck, legs, ears, arms, feet, toes etc. - Draw a picture of your family and label it. - Write words or sentences about yourself. You could make your own poster to present this information. You could include: your favourite food, sport, TV show, colour or games you like to play.  <p>SPAG</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Capital Letters: Write a list of the children in our class. Make sure you use a capital letter for names. - Practise spelling the days of the week and months of the year. - Practise the phase 2 and 3 tricky words on Year 1 class page. <p>Further lessons visit Oak National Academy.</p>

<p>Science- Animals Including humans</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Draw pictures and label animals in the 6 animal groups: fish, birds, amphibians, mammals, reptiles and invertebrates. - Point out the differences between these groups by writing words or sentences i.e fur, fins, scales etc. 	



- Draw and label animals as carnivores, herbivores or omnivores. Think about how they are similar and different.
- Name and label the structures of common animals i.e trunk, wings etc.

Religious Education- Belonging- Baptism

- We all belong to the school, 'St Joseph's' use your jumper and try and copy your badge. Think about other groups you belong to e.g. swimming, Rainbows, Beavers, dancing, football etc.
- Watch [this video](#) about 'The story of Jesus with the children'. Draw a picture about this.
- Find out about your Baptism. Ask adults to show you reminders of your Baptism e.g. photos, certificates, candles, cards, clothing, shawls etc. Ask and talk to your family about what happened.
- Draw and decorate a baptismal candle. Put your name on your candle to create an image of the family of Jesus.

Geography- What is my place like?

- Can you find the school grounds on Google Earth? Can you spot the KS1 yard, Reception yard, the staff car park?
- Look outside your window and write down what the weather is like today - do this over the course of a week. Think about whether the weather changed? How has the weather changed?
- Design a new playground. What would you include in our playground? How would you make it better?

- Look at the book 'Funnybones' and make your own skeleton from materials around your home i.e. tin foil, straws, paint a picture of the skeletons or use chalk.
