Year 2 Project- Autumn 2- Dinosaurs	
<p>Maths Tasks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Access White Rose Maths home learning materials. - Play on Times Tables Rockstars, Try to master you 2, 5 and 10 times tables. - Choose a number between 1 and 50. Can you represent this number in as many ways as possible? E.g. using dienes blocks, straws, beads, counters, words, tens frame. - Can you practise counting in 2s to 24, 5s to 60 and 10s to 120? - Play on Hit the Button. Practise your number bonds to 10 and addition within 10. - Make a timetable of your day. Can you write all the things you have been doing and what time you did them? E.g. 7 o'clock get up, half past 7 have breakfast, 9 o'clock read a book. 	<p>Reading Tasks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read a book every day. This could be on Oxford Reading Buddy or one from home. - Listen to a story read by someone else. You could use this online story telling website, storyline. - Books to read/listen to online <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tyrannosaurus Drip- Julia Donaldson - Tyrone the Horrible- Hans Wilhelm - Comprehension <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Watch one of 'Deadly Dinosaur' episodes on BBC iPlayer. Can you tell someone about the dinosaur from the episode? Give it your own deadly rating. - Think of 10 questions about a book you have read. Can you ask them to somebody else who has read the book? - Write a book review about a book you have read. Can you write how you feel about the book? What are your favourite parts and characters?
<p>Phonics/Spelling Tasks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Practise Phase 3 and phase 5 sounds - Practise Phase 3 and phase 5 tricky words - Practise Year 2 common exception words. <p>(Links to all these documents on the class page of school website)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Choose 5 dinosaur names. Can you add the sound buttons and read them? <p>Useful Spelling Websites</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Phonics play - Top Marks - Spelling - Spelling City 	<p>Writing Tasks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Write a description of your favourite dinosaur. Remember to use adjectives. - Design your own dinosaur, give it a name and write a description about it. What does it look like? What does it eat? What interesting features does it have? - Write a story (similar to Tyrannosaurus Drip) where a dinosaur egg goes missing. Where does it end up? What happens to the baby dinosaur? <p>SPAG</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Write 5 sentences about dinosaurs. Don't forget your capital letters and full stops. Can you include a conjunction? (and, but because) - Find as many words as you can that have an apostrophe for a contraction (don't, can't, didn't). Can you use these in your own sentences?
<p>Foundation Subjects</p> <p>Science- Animals and Humans Can you make a list of all the things that humans need to survive? Which ones are the most important? Find out the differences between carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. Can you think of 3 animals for each category?</p> <p>Geography- Why is my world wonderful? Can you draw your own world map? Label all the 7 continents. Can you find one fact about each continent? Can you make a list of the world's main oceans and seas? Can you find some information about a famous mountain range (Alps, Pyrenees, Himalayas)?
