## Whole School Wilderness Workshops

Over the next 7 school days, children from Nursery to Year 5 will take part in a full day outdoor workshop. This workshop will be linked to some of the curriculum areas which they have covered this year. Below are the dates of each year group's outdoor day:

- Monday 21<sup>st</sup> March- **Year 5**- Desert island survival workshop
- Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> March- **Reception**- Nature crafts
- Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> March AM- **Nursery**- Nature crafts
- Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> March- **Year 4**- Arctic survival workshop
- Friday 25<sup>th</sup> March- **Year 1**- Nature crafts
- Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March- **Year 3**- Stone Age workshop
- Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> March- **Year 2**- Antarctic survival workshop

On these days, children will take part in a variety of activities including:

- Creating fire using a fire steel
- Making their own shelters
- Tasting food cooked over an open fire
- Making things using natural materials
- Trying on clothes which explorers wear in extreme environments

Children will be working outside all day so they will need to come to school in warm clothes with waterproof coats in case of bad weather. Children will be working outside and near a fire. With this in mind, we advise that children wear old clothes that they do not mind getting dirty and smelling of smoke.
